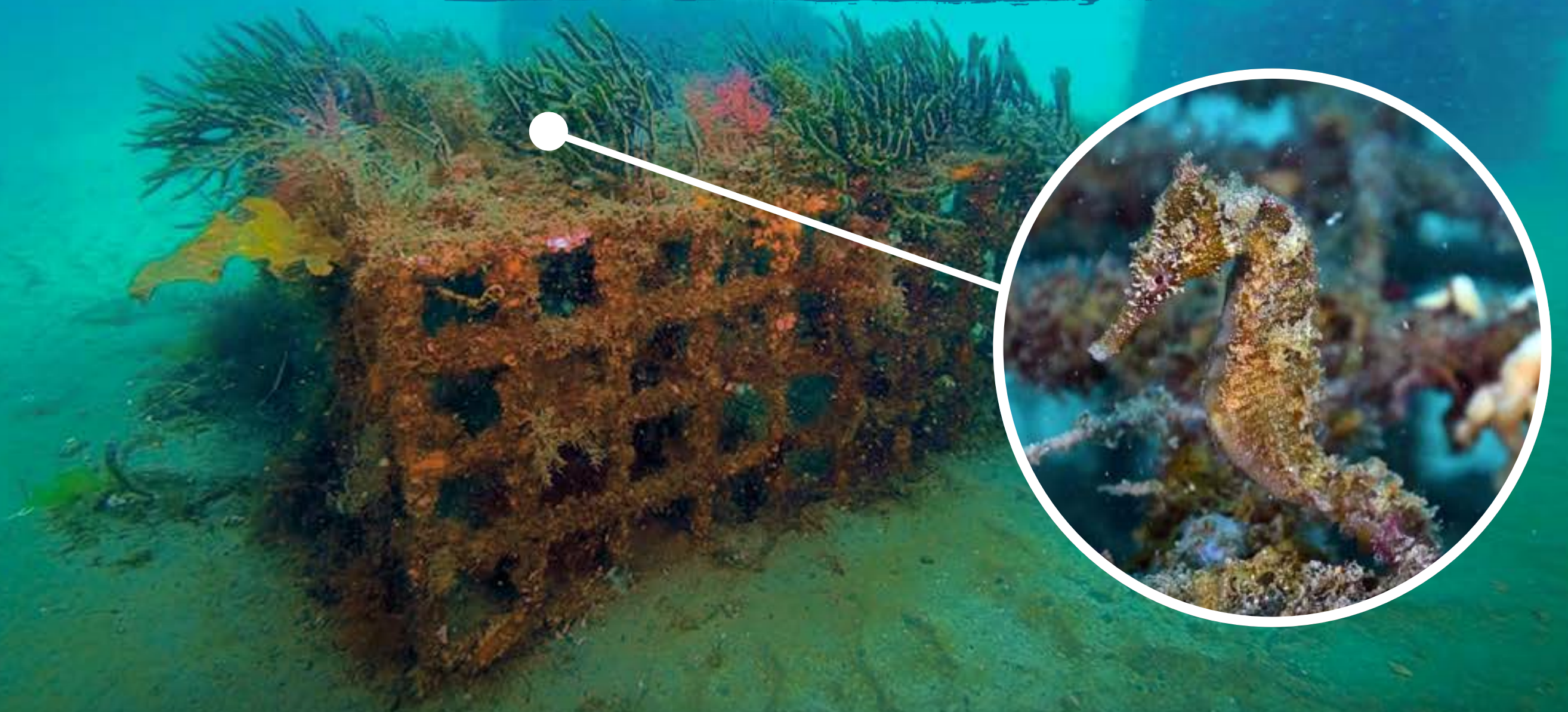
Sydney Harbour's seahorses are in trouble
