The **Cerrado in Brazil** is one of the most important and underrated ecosystem on Earth.

It is home to **5% of all plant and animal species** and plays a crucial role in South America's water cycle.
Yet most people haven't even heard of it.

Cerrado does something extraordinary. Its deep-rooted plants act like a giant sponge:



☁️ Absorb rainwater → 💧 Store it underground → 🌄 Release it into rivers that flow to the Amazon.

Without the Cerrado, the Amazon's water cycle could collapse.



**In just 50 years, more than
half of the Cerrado has
been destroyed.**

**What was once one vast, thriving
ecosystem is now reduced to
isolated islands of wilderness in a
sea of soybean fields.**



But there's hope.

Our partner, **the Black Jaguar Foundation**, found a solution to reconnect these islands of forest.

Using a Brazilian law that requires farmers to dedicate a part of their land to nature, they're helping farmers restore degraded areas.

Piece by piece, these restored areas will connect, forming a 2,600km wildlife corridor across Brazil.

Here's how we're supporting them:



🌱 Funding native seed collection and nursery

🌳 Planting of trees

💻 Monitoring the area for 3 years

Planet Wild funding will support restoration of 30 hectares, contributing to this massive wildlife corridor.
